## Our Christian Cornerstone

**Bible Lessons This Week:** **Through the gift of faith, believers trust in God**, and we see this in the lesson where **Abraham Trusts God** followed by **Abraham and Lot**. We learn how Abraham obeyed God's call to go to a new land. Although he had never seen this land, his "eyes of faith" saw God's promises to bless him. In the second lesson, the students learn Abraham was bold because he trusted in God to protect him, and he was unselfish because he trusted God to provide for him. God protects us and provides for us. Try an at-home activity of tracing your child(ren)'s hands and put "God Protects" on one hand and "God Provides" on the other. Label each finger accordingly with what God provides/protects. Finish the activity by saying a prayer of thanksgiving for all that the Lord does for us.

**Bible Lessons For Next Week:** **God keeps His promises and answers prayer**, begins with the lesson of **God Promises Abraham a Son** followed by **God Answers Abraham's Prayer**. We learn how God strengthened Abraham and Sarah when they worried that they would never have a son. God heard Abraham's prayer and gave him even more than he had asked. God hears our prayers and often gives us more than we ask. Make a list of people for whom your family would like to pray. Read the list and pray, perhaps at dinner or bedtime with the whole family. As you pray, remember our



Lord's promises: "*If two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven.*" (Matthew 18:19).
