Bible Lessons For This Week:

This week's theme, **God works in us so we can serve by good works**, begins with the lesson of *Saul Becomes King*, where students learn how Saul humbly served God as Israel's first king and will also discuss how we can serve God by serving others. In one of our memory treasures, Galatians 5:13, Paul urges us, "Serve one another in love." Another memory treasure, Mark 10:45, reminds us why we serve others: "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

In the next lesson, *Saul Disobeys God*, students learn how God rejected Saul as king because Saul rejected him. Saul disobeyed God and then took his sin lightly, by lying and making excuses for himself instead of being sorry and repenting.
