Bible Lessons For This Week:

This week's theme, **God is the Lord of life and death**, begins with *Elijah Goes to Heaven* in which students learn that the prophet Elijah wanted to die, but God had more work for him to do. Then when God decided it was time, he took Elijah to heaven. Many people have wrong ideas about death and eternal life. Discuss with your



child what's wrong with these statements:

- We should fear death. (Earthly death brings heavenly life.)
- We should want to die. (God gives us earthly blessings and pleasures that He intends for us to enjoy while here on earth.)
- We can decide when and how we want to die. (God is in control.)

In the next lesson, *A Boy Comes Back to Life*, students learn that although a

woman had been barren for many years, God gave her a son. Then he allowed the child to die and, through Elisha, raised him again. We thank God for giving us life, and we trust Him to give us eternal life as He has promised.

ATTENTION!

6TH GRADE PARENTS . . .

Minnesota [state law 121A.15](#) states that all incoming 7th graders must have had all previously required immunizations and plus either show proof of receiving a Tdap and Meningococcal immunization OR have the proper signatures on the back of [this form](#) for either a medical condition or a conscientious exemption.

. . . & KINDERGARTEN PARENTS

Minnesota state law (linked above) states that all incoming kindergarten students must show proof of either receiving the immunizations listed below or have the proper signatures on the back of this form (linked above) for either a medical condition or a conscientious exemption.

- Hepatitis B - 3 immunizations
- DTaP/DT - 5 immunizations
- Polio - 4 immunizations
- MMR - 2 immunizations
