FLU CLINIC ~ FALL 2017

RLS has partnered with your child's clinic to provide the flu vaccine at school. This is a convenient way to keep your children, our school and community healthy throughout the year.

What's new? There is a **FIXED** registration period this year beginning online on Aug 9th and ending on Sept 13th (midnight). No registration forms will be accepted after midnight on Sept 13.

What else do I need to know?

Registration is required.

Online registration is preferred.

Paper forms will be available at the school and meet-the-teacher events (Back to School Picnic, Aug 24 & Orientation, Aug 29)

Only the flu shot is available this year.

Non-medication pain reducing options will be offered.

Your health insurance will be billed just like it is in your clinic.

Your child can get the vaccine free if you don't have insurance.

Please make sure your child wears clothing that allows access to the upper arm.
