

## **Goodhue Tournament 2018**

The Goodhue Tournament is a round robin tournament. Most teams will play three games. (Goodhue will play four.) The champion will be the team with 3 wins.

If there is a tie in wins/losses we will then look at three things in order:

1. Head to head competition.
2. Fewest points allowed for all the games played.
3. Most points scored in games that your team lost.

### **Tournament Particulars and Rules**

1. Time outs: three sixty-second timeouts and two thirty-second timeouts per game.
2. Game length
  - 2 twenty minute halves
  - entire first half running clock-timeouts clock stops
  - second half running clock until last 2 minutes is stopped clock if game is 12 points or less.
3. Pressing is allowed until point spread is 12 points or more.
4. Each school realizes that ages and talents vary among school students. When the score of a game indicates an early winner and there is time left on the clock, please play the game as a teaching tool. Please refrain from a high pressure defense and fast breaks. Please rotate less experienced players with starters.
5. Three point shots will be honored.
6. Foul shots follow high school rules. Bonus shots on the 7<sup>th</sup> foul and double bonus on the 10<sup>th</sup> foul.
7. Tie games-we will play an extension of the second half with another two minutes of stopped time until a winner is declared.
8. Half time will be 3 minutes unless coaches agree to a shorter time. Warm up times between games are 10 minutes unless coaches agree to a shorter time.
9. Goodhue volunteers will run the official book and the clock.
